One of the most painful challenges facing the Jewish community is the issue of the *agunah*, a wife trapped in a dead marriage, chained to a husband who refuses to grant her a *Get* (religious divorce). Unable to remarry, unable to move forward, these women's lives are passing them by. *Mekudeshet*, a documentary by Anat Zuria, chronicles the struggle of three young Israeli women to obtain a *Get* with the help of a group of *Toanot* (Orthodox female rabbinical court advocates).
